**Aspen Family Portal:** Aspen is a secure Student Information Management System. The Manchester School District uses Aspen to manage student information including grading, scheduling, attendance, special education and other data. Parents and guardians can register for an account to log into Aspen to view basic school-related information about their children. At the elementary school level, they have access to daily attendance and report card grade information. 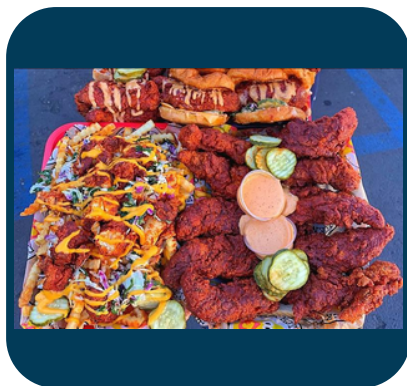
